Thank you for pre-registering! Here are the facts for ODA Annual Session attendees:

PICK UP YOUR BADGE AND LANYARD ON-SITE

New this year, your badge will not be mailed to you. Stop by the Registration Area in Concourse B of the Greater Columbus Convention Center (GCCC) to print off your badge by using the barcode in your pre-arrival email or simply by providing your name and ID. Any applicable ribbons will also be available on-site. Members of the ODA House of Delegates can pick up their badges in front of the Aminah Robinson Ballroom on floor #5 at the Hilton Downtown Columbus Hotel.

ONLINE HANDOUTS

The ODA will provide course handout materials online. To retrieve your handouts, simply log back into your account with your last name and badge number or the username and password that you created at <https://www.prereg.net/2025/oda>. The handout option will be located on the left-hand side of the website after you log in – a small cloud icon appears next to each course that has a hand-out. Please remember that not all speakers provide handouts and some speakers provide handouts just before their course, so check back often. **Printed handouts will not be available on-site at Annual Session.**

EVENT LOCATIONS

CE courses and events will be held in the Greater Columbus Convention Center (GCCC) 400 N. High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, and the Hilton Downtown Columbus Hotel, Tower 402, 402 N. High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. This year, all events and meetings located at the GCCC are near the B Concourse. Classroom numbers beginning with "B" are in the GCCC directly across from the ODA Exhibit Hall and the ODA Annual Session Registration area. Classroom numbers beginning with "C" are in the GCCC just north of the ODA Annual Session Registration area, near the Goodale Garage entrance. Please check the meeting app and signage located throughout the buildings to determine in which room your meeting or event is located.

NAME BADGE

Your name badge must be worn at all times while at Annual Session and is your entry into the Exhibit Hall and free events.

NO TICKETS NEEDED!

A barcode on the front of your name badge allows you to be easily scanned in for each course and event that you have registered for. Your personalized schedule is printed on one side of the badge and folds to be an easy reference on the back of your badge.

CHANGING YOUR REGISTRATION

Changes to your registration cannot be made by phone. However, changes can be made on-site at the ODA Registration Desk located in Concourse B of the GCCC.

Please plan to arrive no later than one hour before your first CE program begins.

SEMINAR SEATING & COURTESY

Plan to arrive early; seating for all seminars is on a first-come, first-served basis. Most lecture rooms are set in a mixture of classroom (with tables) and theatre (without tables) seating, so arriving early can guarantee that you have your choice in seating arrangements. Also, please set all cell phones and pagers to silent during seminars.

LUNCH BREAKS

On Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, most CE courses will break for two hours for lunch at various intervals between 11:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., giving attendees the opportunity to spend time in the Exhibit Hall with no need to travel off-site for lunch. Concessions and a dining areas are located in the Exhibit Hall and Concourse B. On Saturday, free lunch will be available in the Exhibit Hall for all attendees from 12:00 pm to 1:45 p.m.

CE RECORDS AND VERIFICATION



Annual Session will feature a computerized accreditation process. Sponsored by the ODA Services Corp., the system allows attendees to print out a final CE certificate on-site during the convention, or from your home or office.

Speakers will announce a confirmation code(s) sometime during the seminar. Be sure to make note of the CE code; it is your back-up, just in case!

The final document that you print out yourself is the only course confirmation document you will receive. To print your certificate on-site, visit the CE Pavilion located near the concession area in the back of the Exhibit Hall. On Saturday afternoon the CE Pavilion will relocate to the ODA Annual Session Registration Desk. If you prefer not to use the system on-site, you may print your CE certification forms online from your home or office computer. Simply go to the ODA's website, www.oda.org, click on the 2025 CEU Credits link and enter your Annual Session badge number and the first four letters of your last name. You will then be able to enter the appropriate CE verification codes, if needed, and print out your personalized CE certificate.

ONLINE CE COURSES

Remember, your Annual Session Registration includes access to 14 hours of free online CE courses. The recorded online courses are different than the courses offered during the live ODA Annual Session in Columbus. The online courses are available through your Annual Session registration portal accessible by your Registration ID number which is printed on your badge, and your last name. Courses will be available starting Monday, September 29, 2025, and end at midnight on December 31, 2025.

Next year's ODA Annual Session will be held September 17 – 19, 2026 at the Hilton Columbus Downtown Hotel and the Greater Columbus Convention Center. Stop by the ODA Membership Booth at this year's convention to pick up your handy reminder of next year's dates.
